


ST. LAWRENCE

August 10 – Deacon and Martyr - +258

St. Lawrence, the Patron of the Poor, was a deacon of Rome. He was entrusted with the care of the goods and the charities of the Church. In 257, after the martyrdom of Pope Sixtus II and four deacons at the Catacombs of St. Callixtus, Lawrence sold the sacred vessels and distributed all the money in his hands to the poor. The Prefect of Rome, informed about his generous charities, ordered him to surrender to the emperor the treasures of the Church.

Lawrence came back three days later with all the poor who were supported by the Church. He presented them to the Prefect, saying: These are the treasures of the Church. The Prefect was maddened by his words and decided to have him killed in the most cruel fashion. He ordered Lawrence stripped and put on a gridiron with burning coals under it. Having suffered a long time, he turned to the Prefect and said with a cheerful smile: Let my body be turned; one side is cooked enough. Before giving up his spirit, he prayed for the conversion of Rome. A beautiful basilica was built over his tomb by Emperor Constantine.

ASSUMPTION - August 15

We believe that the Virgin Mary, at the end of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into the glory of Heaven. This truth, that was preached since the earliest centuries, was defined as a dogma of faith by the Servant of God, Pope Pius XII in 1950 with the bull Munificentissimus Deus. It was in Ephesus that the Virgin Mary was seen for the last time and cared for by the apostle St. John. The Church does not specify whether Our Lady died or fell asleep. For sure we know that she was preserved from corruption and taken up into heaven Body and Soul by a unique anticipation of the general resurrection. This privilege was granted to her because she is the Mother of God, and because her body was never stained by any sin. The dogma of the Assumption is supported by the universal tradition of the Church and by the Book of Revelation. A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars (Revelation 12:1).




