

**Marriages:** Marriages are celebrated in the Church where the bride or groom is registered at. When a man and a woman plan to marry each other, they should contact a priest one year in advance and always before the wedding date is set, and before arranging for the reception hall. The engaged are required to attend a Marriage Preparation Course.

Please note: However, if this man or woman has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted. Questions are often being asked about marriages performed outside the Catholic Church by non-Catholic ministers. These are not valid marriages according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, but many can be rectified by simply consulting with your Parish priest to discuss the available options. Sometimes people make decisions without proper information, so if you wish, please contact your Pastor for details or call the Marriage Tribunal at 416-934-3400 ext 300.

# ST. MATTHEW - September 21 Apostle and Evangelist - First Century

St. Matthew, the great apostle and evangelist, was born in Galilee from a certain Alpheus, and was also called Levi. Being a tax collector for the Romans, he was considered a traitor and a public sinner. While he was sitting at the custom post of Capharnaum, Jesus called him. Immediately, Matthew left everything and followed him. When Jesus was at table in Matthew's house, some Pharisees complained that Jesus shared his dinner with tax collectors and sinners. Overhearing the remark, Jesus said: Those who are well do not need a physician, but the sick do. I did not come too call the righteous but sinners (Matthew 9:13). The Gospel of St. Matthew, reflecting his past experience of precise accounting, is the most complete and accurate. In art, Matthew is symbolized by a man, because he began his Gospel with Jesus' human genealogy, while Mark is represented by a lion, Luke by an ox, and John by an eagle. Tradition says that St. Matthew, after evangelizing in Judaea, went to preach to the East, where he suffered martyrdom.

### STS. ANDREW KIM, PAUL, & COMPANIONS September 20 - Priest, Martyrs - +1839-46

Fr. Andrew Kim, seminarian Paul Cheong, and 78 lay persons, suffered martyrdom between 1839 and 1846. The Martyrs of Korea, as they are known, were either beheaded, strangled, or died under torture. They represent only a fraction of the thousands who died in the persecutions that accompanied the evangelization of Korea. Fr. Andrew Kim, the first Korean priest, was born near Seoul in 1821. After his ordination at Shangay in 1845, he returned secretly to Korea and was assigned to arrange for the entrance of foreign missionaries. In the process, he was arrested by the border patrol and beheaded at the Han River near Seoul. His body was exposed publicly for three days. He was designated Patron of the Korean Clergy.

### **DID YOU KNOW THAT.....**

Every <u>CATHOLIC BIBLE</u> on its 1<sup>st</sup> pages has 2 Latin words: "<u>IMPRIMATUR"</u> and "<u>NIHIL OBSTAT"</u> from a bishop who guarantees its authenticity and gives permission for the Book to be printed. Does your Bible have these Latin words in it??

In 400 A.D. St. Jerome translated the Bible from Greek into Latin.... The Bible is called "VULGATE"

In 1236 A.D. books in the Bible were divided into **CHAPTERS** as we have it today.

19 1549 A.D. **VERSES** were added to the Chapters in the Bible.

<u>AGNOSTICS (?)</u> who are they? An **AGNOSTIC** is someone who questions whether God exists, or whether it is even possible to know if He exists at all.


