

Marriages: Marriages are celebrated in the Church where the bride or groom is registered at. When a man and a woman plan to marry each other, they should contact a priest one year in advance and always before the wedding date is set, and before arranging for the reception hall. The engaged are required to attend a Marriage Preparation Course.

Please note: However, if this man or woman has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted. Questions are often being asked about marriages performed outside the Catholic Church by non-Catholic ministers. These are not valid marriages according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, but many can be rectified by simply consulting with your Parish priest to discuss the available options. Sometimes people make decisions without proper information, so if you wish, please contact your Pastor for details or call the Marriage Tribunal at 416-934-3400 ext 300.

#### **BLESSING OF THE EASTER FOOD**

<u>Father will bless your baskets of Easter Food on Holy</u> Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:30am in Keswick

A typical Eastern European Easter basket would include any of these symbolic foods.

- Bacon A symbol of the abundance of God's mercy.
- Bread Usually a braided chałka, representing the staff of life given by God.
- Easter bread A round cake of rich, eggy, yeast dough with raisins reminiscent of the risen Lord.
- Butter Dairy products are included to celebrate the end of Lent and the richness of our salvation. Butter is often shaped into a lamb (symbolic of the Paschal Lamb) and known as a baranek. (When the baranek is made of sugar, it is known as baranek cukrowy wielkanocny.) Sometimes the baranek is made of dough, wood, or even plastic.
- Candle The candle symbolizes Jesus, the "light of the world," and can be lit when the priest blesses the baskets of food.
- Cheese Cheese is a symbol to remind Christians of moderation.
- Coloured eggs Both coloured and uncoloured hard-cooked eggs indicate hope, new life, and Christ rising from his tomb.
- Ham Meats are symbolic of great joy and abundance in celebration of Christ's resurrection.
- Sausage—kiełbasa The sausage links are symbolic of the chains of death that were broken when Jesus rose from the dead, as well as of God's generosity.
- Horseradish This is a reminder of the bitterness and harshness of the Passion of Jesus, and the vinegar it is mixed with symbolizes the sour wine given to Jesus on the cross.
- Salt Salt is present to add zest to life and preserve us from corruption.
- Sweets -. Sweets suggest the promise of eternal life or good things to come gentleness, self-control; against such there is no law.


