

Marriages: Marriages are celebrated in the Church where the bride or groom is registered at. When a man and a woman plan to marry each other, they should contact a priest one year in advance and always before the wedding date is set, and before arranging for the reception hall. The engaged are required to attend a Marriage Preparation Course.

Please note: However, if this man or woman has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted. Questions are often being asked about marriages performed outside the Catholic Church by non-Catholic ministers. These are not valid marriages according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, but many can be rectified by simply consulting with your Parish priest to discuss the available options. Sometimes people make decisions without proper information, so if you wish, please contact your Pastor for details or call the Marriage Tribunal at 416-934-3400 ext 300.

Baptisms

Registration Requirements for **Grade 2** students and for students in **Grades 3-7** who have **NOT** received the Sacraments of 1st Holy Communion and Confession yet.

a) Certificate of Baptism

b) <u>Every</u> candidate will <u>know by heart</u> at registration: Our Father...Hail Mary....Glory Be and <u>the names of the Mysteries of the Rosary</u>, just the following: <u>Joyful Mystery</u>; <u>Luminous</u> <u>Mystery</u>; <u>Sorrowful Mystery</u> and <u>Glorious Mystery</u>

BRAZIL'S PRESIDENT CONSECRATES BRAZIL WHO WILL CONSECRATE CANADA TO OUR LADY?

On Tuesday, May 21, 2019, Brazil's conservative President Jair Boisonaro participated in a ceremony at the presidential palace where government officials, clergy, and two bishops consecrated Brazil – the largest country in South America with 135 million Catholics and 46 million Protestants – to the Virgin Mary, the Mother of Jesus, to ask for divine protection. The ceremony was also held as an act of reparation, a public call for God's forgiveness and mercy.
