# HOW THE TRADITION OF THE CHRISTMAS CRIB WAS STARTED

Christmas in Greccio, Italy 1223

In the year 1223 St. Francis of Assisi came to the town of Greccio where he communicated with a devout, pious man by the name of John, a man of good reputation and an even better life.

Our blessed saint said to John: "Let us remember the little child who was born in Bethlehem, let us remember the discomfort of the baby's needs, laying on the hay in a manger, with an ox and an ass standing by.

When the day of the celebration came people of the area lit up candles and torches. St. Francis saw everything and was very glad. Simple poverty and humility changed this place in Greccio into a new Bethlehem. The people were filled with anticipation. The saint of God was overcome with joy and filled with great happiness.

The solemnity of the Holy Mass was celebrated over the manger and St. Francis, as the deacon that he was, sang the Gospel with a strong voice and then preached to the people about what had happened in Bethlehem.

He spoke of the nativity of the poor King and called the baby the Child of Bethlehem.

There was a virtuous man who then witnessed a little child laying lifeless in the manger and he witnessed our holy saint go up to it and rouse it from deep sleep. It was as if the Child Jesus had been forgotten and was brought back to life again through his servant St. Francis.

After the celebration they took the hay from the manger for safe keeping. Many animals were healed from their illness after eating of this hay, pregnant women delivered safely when some of that hay was placed on them and many of the sick people were healed too through this hay.

Later an altar was built on the place where the manger had stood and a Church was erected.

### **EPIPHANY OF THE LORD – January 6**

The solemnity of the Epiphany, which is Greek means *Manifestation*, commemorates the revelation of Jesus Christ to all peoples, represented by the Magi. The Wise Men, popularly known as the *Three Kings*, came from the Orient to Jerusalem. They asked: *Where is the newborn King of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage*. King Herod was greatly troubled, and assembled all the chief priests and scribes to inquire where the Messiah was to be born. They answered: *In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet Micah: "And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel"* 

Then Herod sent the Magi to Bethlehem and said: Go and search for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage. The Magi set out and were overjoyed at seeing the star, that preceded them until it stopped over the place where the child Jesus was. Upon entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

The coming of the Magi was prophesied by Isaiah, when he wrote: Caravans of camels shall fill you, dromedaries from Midian and Ephah; all from Sheba shall come bearing gold and frankincense, and proclaiming the praises of the Lord (Isaiah 60:6). They were interpreted as kings because of an Old Testament prophecy: May the kings of Tarshis and the islands bring tribute, the kings of Arabia and Seba offer gifts. May all kings bow before him, all nations serve him (Psalm 72:10-11). The star was announced by Balaam, when he said: A star shall advance from Jacob, and a staff shall rise from Israel (Numbers 24:17). Tradition holds that the Magi numbered three; their names Gaspar, Mechor, and Balthasar. Their gifts had a symbolic meaning. Gold, the royal metal, signified that Jesus was King; frankincense, symbol of prayer, that Jesus was God; God; myrrh, used to anoint the dead, that Jesus had to die for the salvation of all.

O Holy St. Anthony, gentlest of Saints, your love for God and Charity for His creatures, made you worthy, when on earth, to possess miraculous powers. Encouraged by this thought, I implore you to obtain for me (request). O gentle and loving St. Anthony, whose heart was ever full of human sympathy, whisper my petition into the ears of the sweet Infant Jesus, who loved to be folded in your arms; and the gratitude of my heart will ever be yours. Amen.
