Feast of St. Luke, Evangelist October 18, 2024



On October 18, we celebrate the feast day of St. Luke. There are only a few certain facts about St. Luke's life. We know him best as the author of the third Gospel and of the Acts of the Apostles. A Greek himself, he wrote the story of Jesus and the Christian

community for Gentile readers. He also accompanied St. Paul on some of his journeys and shared in his sufferings. Probably a physician, Luke may have pioneered as an early member of the Church at Antioch.

The Saint's books reveal something about his character: Luke wrote excellent popular prose with an artist's skill at painting picture stories. Demonstrating an unusual commitment to accuracy, he appears to have fastidiously checked his facts. For example, archaeologists have confirmed many details that he reported in the Acts.

Some of Luke's main themes - prayer, the Holy Spirit, and mercy - suggest that he was a compassionate, spiritual man. His books were aimed at persuading Gentiles that the Christian story was true, by filling his Gospel with accounts of Christ's openness and mercy. Tradition says Luke lived a long life without marrying and that he died at age eighty-four. *Loyola Press*

CONGRATULATIONS



Our Holy Father Pope Francis announced a Consistory for the creation of 21 new Cardinals from around the world to be held in Vatican City on 8 December 2024 (Feast of the Immaculate Conception). Our beloved Archbishop of Toronto, the Most Reverend Francis Leo, is among those who will be elevated to the College of Cardinals and will become the

18th Cardinal in the history of the Catholic Church in Canada.

Cardinal-elect Leo commented on the appointment: *"I am humbled and honoured to receive this appointment from the Holy Father. I pray and rely on the prayers of the faithful in Toronto that I will be a worthy servant of the Lord Jesus in fulfilling my responsibilities as a member of the College of Cardinals and to continue in my primary role as shepherd of the faithful of the Archdiocese of Toronto. I entrust to the Blessed Mother Mary, myself and this new ministry of service to the Universal Church and to the Successor of St. Peter, the Pope."*

As we wish his Excellency Most Reverend Francis Cardinal-elect Leo our prayerful congratulations, let us continue to keep him in our daily prayers for God's blessings, along with Blessed Mother Mary's guidance.
