# **Prayer for Christian Unity**

The week of Prayer for Christian Unity is celebrated around the world on January 18-25, which are also the dates recommended by Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. However, there has also been a standing practice by a number of communities to celebrate the Week of Prayer on optional dates, in order to include two Sundays.

This universal week of prayer encourages Christians of all denominations to meet, to participate in various liturgical and other community activities, and to pray together that all may be one, as Christ desires. The importance of unity among Christians and the responsibility of the people of each parish to work for this unity should be emphasized throughout the week. All members of the parish should seek to have a deeper understanding of ecumenism. ORDO

Every year, Christians from a different host country choose the theme and prepare draft texts for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (WPCU).

The 2025 theme for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (WPCU) chosen by the community of Bose, an ecumenical monastery of brothers and sisters in northern Italy is, "Do you believe this?" Based on John 11:26, the international theme and

materials call Christians to reflect on their common faith, and, while awaiting Christ's return, to witness together to this faith in the resurrection, which is for them the source of hope and joy, to be shared with all peoples.

God our Father, accept our praise and thanksgiving for what already unites Christians in the confession of and witness to Jesus the Lord. converted on the road to Damascus when Our Lord appeared to him in His resurrected glory (see Acts 9:1-9). From this point, he took the name Paul and would become the "Apostle to the Gentiles."
