Feast of St. Philips and St. James, May 3, 2025



Saints Philip and James were two of the Twelve Apostles chosen by Jesus. Philip was from Bethsaida, the same town as Peter and Andrew. He was one of the first to follow Jesus, and he quickly shared the good news with others. James, known as James the Less to distinguish him from James the Greater, was the son of Alphaeus. He is sometimes called James the Younger. Both of these men spent their lives following Jesus and spreading His teachings.
The Church remembers Philip and James together.

This is because their relics were brought to Rome and placed together in the Basilica of the Holy Apostles. Since then, they have been celebrated on the same feast day. Honouring them together shows the unity of the apostles in their mission.

Their feast day is May 3. On this day, the Church reflects on their example of faith and dedication. The feast day is a reminder of their loyalty and their work in spreading the message of Jesus. It is a day to honour their courage and their love for God.

Philip and James each brought their own gifts to the early Church. Philip was known for his questions, which helped others see the truth of Jesus' words. James was known for his wisdom and leadership, especially in Jerusalem. Today, the Church looks to Saints Philip and James as examples of faith, strength, and commitment. Younge Catholics
