One part of Catholic culture that is sometimes hard to understand and very often misunderstood is the custom of offering **Mass intentions.** 

When a priest celebrates Mass each day, he *offers* each celebration of the Eucharist for a particular person, or intention. By doing so, he applies special graces from God upon that person or intention.

Similar to how we are able to intercede for others by our personal prayers, the Church is able to intercede for us through the celebration of the Mass. However, since the Eucharist is the "source and summit of the Christian life" the Mass possesses a power that our personal prayers do not.

The important part is to remember that you are not paying for the *graces* from God (which are of infinite value and cannot be paid for), but for the material things that are involved with celebrating that particular Mass.

# The Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God The Octave Day of the Nativity of the Lord

(Holy Day of Obligation)



On January 1, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. This day closes the Octave of Christmas by honouring Mary's unique role in the mystery of the Incarnation. The Church's teaching that Mary is the Mother of God was already present in Revelation and

was part of doctrinal teaching before it was officially declared a dogma. The child Mary bore, Jesus Christ, is truly both divine and human. By acknowledging that Mary is the Mother of God, the Church safeguards both the divinity and humanity of Christ. Mary is rightly called Mother of God, a title defended at the Council of Ephesus in 431 A.D. against the Christological error of Nestorianism. This heresy implied that Jesus could be divided into two persons with Mary as the mother of Christ the Man, but not the mother of a Divine Person who became Man. The Council rejected this notion and declared Mary the Theotokos, or God-bearer.

Mary became the Mother of God's only Son through the power of the Holy Spirit. But her maternal role was not passive. With the words, "I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be done unto me according to your word" (Luke 1:38), she gave her consent—and God entered our world through her unconditional cooperation with His plan.

As we embark on a new year, may we entrust ourselves to Our Lady's maternal care, asking for her intercession to lead us ever closer to her Son, Jesus Christ. May her maternal intercession accompany our pilgrimage of faith this year. EWTN

#### **Plastic Milk Bags** for the Homeless in our Community

Save your clean, three-litre milk bags to help homeless people and reduce plastic in landfill sites. We are asking all our parishioners to start collecting, cleaning and donating their plastic outer-shell milk bags to both our Churches. There will be bins provided and you can leave your milk bags (best folded) in the bins. They must be clean and dry to avoid mold.

Drying Tip: Turn bags inside out – no wiping – air dry They will be picked up once a month and then turned into mats that will be given to the homeless. It takes 500 bags to make one mat and many hours to complete. The mats are water-resistant and provide insulation from the cold and wet ground. Thank you for your support!




