Protect against scam emails. Keep an eye out for:

- Money or information requests** — Clergy and the bishop will never ask for money, gift cards, or personal information via email.
- Urgent language** — Does the email have vague but urgent language? (Ex: "I'm in a meeting right now, but please send me the gift cards as quickly as possible!")
- Fraudulent email addresses** — Check the email address against what is listed on the church or diocesan website.

Why Lent Is Important:

Lent is a season of transformation. It is a time to reset, reflect, and spiritually prepare for the most profound celebration in the Christian calendar: the Resurrection of Christ at Easter. Each year, millions of Catholics around the world enter into this solemn period of 40 days, marked by **prayer, fasting, and almsgiving**. But why is Lent so important? Why do we take this time to reflect on our lives, our relationship with God, and the world around us? The answer lies in the call to become closer to Christ, to experience a deeper connection with His suffering and sacrifice, and ultimately to embrace the hope of His victory over death.

Stations of the Cross in Lent

As part of our Lenten journey, one of the most powerful and intimate practices is praying the Stations of the Cross. This 14-step devotion allows us to walk with Jesus through His final hours on Earth, beginning

with His condemnation to death and ending with His body being laid in the tomb. Each station is a poignant reminder of His love, sacrifice, and the depths of His suffering for our salvation.

Why are the Stations of the Cross so vital during Lent? Because they invite us to step into the shoes of the suffering Christ, to witness firsthand the pain He endured, not just as a historical event, but as a present reality in our lives. We are invited to make His journey our own, reflecting on how His suffering intersects with our own struggles, pain, and losses. In this sacred moment, we find both sorrow and strength, knowing that Christ's suffering was not in vain. It was for us - for our salvation, our healing, and our renewal. As you journey through the 40 days of Lent, consider making the Stations of the Cross a part of your spiritual practice. Whether you pray them alone, with your family, or in a community, these 14 stations will bring you closer to the heart of Christ. And in doing so, they'll draw you closer to the hope, the renewal, and the resurrection that Easter promises.


