Through ShareLife, you helped Tara rebuild her life. Tara's childhood was anything but safe.

Conflict and fear filled her days, and as she grew older, home became unbearable. She waited, hoping things would change, but she had to leave once she became a teenager. Because of your warm heart, Tara found safety at Covenant House Toronto, a Catholic Charities agency you support through ShareLife. After a short stay in the crisis shelter, she moved into the Rights of Passage (ROP) program, determined to rebuild her life. You gave Tara the strength to take charge of her future, adding her name to waitlists for affordable housing and taking steps to stand on her own. In the meantime, she balanced multiple part-time jobs while staying in school, saving every dollar she could. With your caring support, she connected with a counsellor to begin working through the challenges that had forced her to leave home. 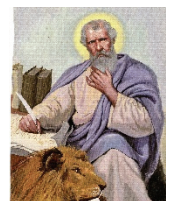
Feast of St. Mark

The Church celebrates the Feast Day of St. Mark, Apostle and Evangelist, on April 25.

He was one of the four writers of the Gospels, who provide us with a clear account of the life and teaching of Jesus Christ. We know St. Mark, therefore, mostly through his authorship of the second Gospel—the Gospel according to St. Mark. From elsewhere in Scripture, he is also known to have accompanied Paul and Barnabas on their journeys. From tradition, he is known to have been the secretary of St. Peter and the founder of the Church in Alexandria, Egypt.

As with saints generally, St. Mark's feast day is the day of his death. On April 25, 68 A.D., he was dragged through the streets of Alexandria for his faith in Christ, leaving both blood and flesh on the pavement stones. During the entire time, he never ceased praising God and thanking Him for his sufferings.

In addition to being the founder and patron of the Coptic Church, and Egypt itself, St. Mark is the patron saint of the city of Venice, Italy, many other cities, some professions, such as lawyers, and healing from some diseases (such as scrofula). *EWTN*
