The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

June 7, 2026

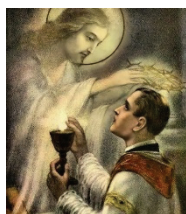


The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to “Body of Christ”. This feast originated in France in the mid-thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. This feast is celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday or, as in the USA and Canada, on the Sunday following that feast.

This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus’ suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist.

At every Mass, our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with His disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others. *EWTN*



The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (Solemnity)

June 12, 2026

“The heart of Christ, as the symbol of the deepest and most personal source of His love for us, is the very core of the initial preaching of the Gospel. It stands at the origin of our faith, as the wellspring that refreshes and enlivens our Christian beliefs”. With these words, Pope Francis expressed himself in his encyclical *Dilexit nos* on the human and divine love of the Heart of Jesus Christ, dated October 24, 2024.

In the document, the Pontiff explained the meaning of the Heart of Christ:

“Devotion to the heart of Christ is not the veneration of a single organ apart from the Person of Jesus. What we contemplate and adore is the whole Jesus Christ, the Son of God made man, represented by an image that accentuates His heart. That heart of flesh is seen as the privileged sign of the inmost being of the incarnate Son and His love, both

divine and human. More than any other part of His body, the heart of Jesus is ‘the natural sign and symbol of His boundless love.’”

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is clearly shown in two episodes from the Gospel: when John rests on Jesus’ chest during the Last Supper, and when, on the Cross, Jesus’ Heart is pierced. In the first instance, we see Jesus offering affection and comfort just before His death. In the second, He reveals His sorrow for the sins of humanity. These two moments help us better understand the message Jesus entrusted to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1675: This is the Heart that has so loved men, but receives in return only ingratitude, contempt, offenses, sacrileges, and indifference. I ask you to institute a special feast on the first Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi to honour My Heart by receiving Communion and making reparation for the offenses It receives when exposed on the altars. I promise that My Heart will open to pour out abundantly the divine love on those who will honour It and lead others to do the same.

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is a movable feast—its date changes every year—but its meaning is so profound that it shapes the entire month of June in the life of the Church. It is celebrated on the Friday following the Solemnity of Corpus Christi and is also linked to the following day, Saturday, which is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

In the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we see united: the human heart of Christ (true man) and his divinity (true God). It is the symbol of His infinite love for humanity.
