Sunday, September 27, 2026**

This year's theme, chosen by Pope Leo XIV, is "Even just one of these children".

Drawing from the Gospel of Matthew (18:5) - "Whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me" - the Holy Father calls the Church to pay special attention to migrants and refugee children. He reminds us that every child matters, and we are called to protect and welcome them with open hearts, offering them safety, dignity, and a hopeful future. We are invited to reflect on how our parishes and communities can respond with concrete acts of hospitality and compassion to the youngest and most vulnerable among those on the move.
