**Feast of St. Michael, St. Gabriel, St. Raphael,
Archangels, September 29**



The Archangels, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael are among the highest-ranking spiritual beings, created by God before the world began. They have no material body and are immortal, serving as God's messengers and executors of Divine tasks. Their roles and missions reflect their names, which signify the specific missions they have received from God. Let us explore each archangel's identity, mission, and how they continue to influence the faithful today.

The Feast of the Archangels, celebrated on September 29, honours Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, together. This feast day is an opportunity for the faithful to reflect on the significant roles these archangels have played in salvation history and continue to play in the Church today. In earlier times, each archangel had a separate feast day - St. Michael's was celebrated on September 29 (Michaelmas), St. Gabriel's on March 24, and St. Raphael's on October 24. However, in the liturgical reforms of 1969, these feast days were combined to honour all three archangels on the same day.

The archangels are invoked in prayers and devotions for various purposes. St. Michael is often called upon for protection, especially in the "St. Michael Prayer," composed by Pope Leo XIII to defend against the evil forces. St. Gabriel is invoked for strength in delivering God's messages and trusting in His plans. St. Raphael is called upon for healing and safe journeys.

The faithful often turn to these archangels in times of difficulty, seeking their intercession for protection, guidance, and healing. Their unique roles as messengers, healers, and warriors serve as a reminder of God's constant care and intervention in the world.

The Archangels, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael are powerful messengers and protectors sent by God. They remind us of the invisible reality of spiritual warfare, divine healing, and the ever-present assistance that God provides through His heavenly hosts. On their feast day, we are invited to deepen our devotion to these great archangels, who continue to inspire and guide us in our spiritual journey. *Catholic Heroes*

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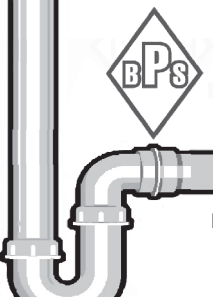


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
